SERVE is an annual community outreach. The purpose is to SHOW the gospel by loving and serving our city and to SHARE the gospel through gospel conversations. At NewBranch, we are FOR our community, and we desire to demonstrate this to our friends and neighbors who live, work and play around us.

HOW CAN I PARTICIPATE?

PRAY: Pray that God would provide opportunities to have gospel conversations with those we meet and that God would open hearts to draw them to Him.

Several mornings during the week there will be a group gathering to pray in various locations. If you work during the day and are unable to serve, please consider joining an early morning prayer gathering close to your home.

Prayer guides will be sent out by email daily to our church family with specific things to pray for so that even those who aren't able to serve physically, can join in prayer.

Even young children can join you in prayer with the kids prayer guides that will also be sent by email.

DONATE: Follow the link in the Bulletin to sign up to donate various items for public servant gift baskets, The Haven welcome baskets, and other donations.

SERVE: Sign up to join the teams for daily serving events. Refer to the schedule of activities on the back page of this packet.

HOW DO I SIGN UP?

To sign up, go to the Church Center app or scan the QR code on the back page of this packet. Here's what you need to know about signing up...

- Refer to the tentative calendar of events for the week and sign up for the events that you and your family **will plan** to attend.
- **T-shirt size**: please make sure you sign up each family member separately so you have a shirt for everyone to wear when you serve. Wear your shirt at each serving opportunity.
- Please try to sign up as soon as you can so that we can plan accordingly and make adjustments to the schedule if needed.
 The deadline to sign up is Sunday, May 12th.

WHY?

Our goal is to show the love of Christ to those in our community. That's why we have chosen to SERVE! As we serve together, there are a number of other benefits.

- Cultivate deeper relationships and unity within the body.
- Different parts of the body get to use their gifts to serve.
- Engage in activities that are out of our comfort zone, stretching and growing us in new ways.
- Develop a culture of serving our community throughout the year.
- Model a servant's heart and sacrifice of self to the children in our church, even if there are no young children in your home.

WHAT TO EXPECT?

- Weekday prayer gatherings will be at 6:00am on the days and locations listed on the calendar.
- Morning SERVE events begin at 9:00am and end around 12:00, unless otherwise noted.
- Evening SERVE events begin at 6:30pm and end around 8:30pm, unless otherwise noted.
- Locations will change each day, depending on the event, so be sure to check the location of the gathering for each day.
- Most days before we begin the service project, we will have a
 brief time of gathering together to worship through singing and
 teaching. As we worship together, we prepare our hearts to serve
 and declare our dependence on the Holy Spirit to work through us
 as we show and share the gospel to our neighbors.

WEEKDAY SERVICE PROJECTS

PUBLIC SERVANT GIFT BASKETS

When we take a gift basket to our local public servants, we have the opportunity to show the love of Jesus and pray for the first responders, local schools and city officials. Volunteers will put together baskets one evening, and later in the week we will divide into teams to drive to several different locations to deliver the baskets. This is a great event for both kids and adults, as the fire stations love to give the kids a tour and maybe even a fire hat!







LINKED IN: MATS FOR UNHOUSED

Start saving your plastic grocery bags! We will be collecting these bags, which will be donated to this organization who makes thick sleeping mats to be distributed to those who are currently unhoused.

PARK GIVEAWAYS

Throughout the week, we will be dividing into teams and heading to the local parks to pass out water bottles and freeze pops, as well as to invite our neighbors to the Community Fun Night. We will also have cornhole boards set up to provide more opportunities to have gospel conversations with those we meet at the park.









CRAFTS & GAMES AT THE PARK

For those joining us in the mornings at the park, we will set up crafts and activities at Duncan Creek Park for our neighbors who come to the park that day. Volunteers will assist kids with a craft, bubbles, chalk, and temporary tattoos and hopefully have opportunities to engage in gospel conversations with parents and invite families to the Community Fun Night.







WEEKDAY SERVICE PROJECTS

BACKYARD BIBLE CLUBS

This a great opportunity to join one of our church members in their backyard and reach their neighborhood kids. Volunteers will assist with the planned activities, such as helping kids listen as a Bible story is told, helping with yard games, serving snacks, and assisting with a craft. The same lesson will be repeated at each location, so if you have kids, feel free to just pick one location to serve and attend.
